Rachel Joy Scott was the first person killed in the Columbine High School shooting on April 20, 1999. After her death, many students that Rachel reached out to shared stories with the Scotts; even preventing one young man from taking his own life. Rachel's Challenge programs provide a sustainable, evidence-based framework for positive climate and culture in schools.

Service Projects

The motto of Junior Auxiliary is "**Care Today - Character Tomorrow.**" It is the Junior Auxiliary of Madison County's desire to make an impact on the children of today, with the hopes that this may foster productive citizens of tomorrow.

Our chapter takes great care to choose and design our projects so that we can help improve the life of the children in Madison County, as well as provide a great service base for the future of our community.

Child Lures

This child safety project seeks to educate third graders in Madison County elementary schools regarding the prevention of childhood sexual exploitation and related crimes against children. Chapter members go into the classrooms under teacher supervision and discuss with the students possible dangerous situations, including suggestions on how to avoid them and how to escape them. The volunteers for this project present in individual classrooms during school hours.

Super Sitters

The JAMC is very fortunate to have the opportunity to partner with the Madison County Fire Department. Together, we host Super Sitters classes for teenage girls, ages 11 and up, within our community. The courses are held at The Denson Robinson Public Works Complex located at 1239 Highway 51, in Madison.

The Super Sitters class is designed to help prepare these girls for babysitting. The course teaches correct methods of CPR, first aid, and other emergencies. Classes are free of charge and open on a first-come first-serve basis with limited space available.

Norma Carroll Ezell Sick Free Schools Campaign

This project is designed to help schools in the Madison County area. We provide our teachers with the necessary supplies to help students stay sick free during the school year. This campaign was started to have JAMC members and others in our community donate items, such as Clorox wipes, Lysol spray, Kleenex, and hand sanitizer for these classrooms. Our committee then packages the supplies and donates them to schools throughout the community.

Finance Projects

We are celebrating over 32 years of promoting safety and welfare for children in Madison County at this year's *Royal Rendezvous*! Our charity event is to raise money for children who are less fortunate in Madison County. This party serves as an opportunity for us to thank all of our corporate sponsors, our community members, and celebrate our members' hard work.
